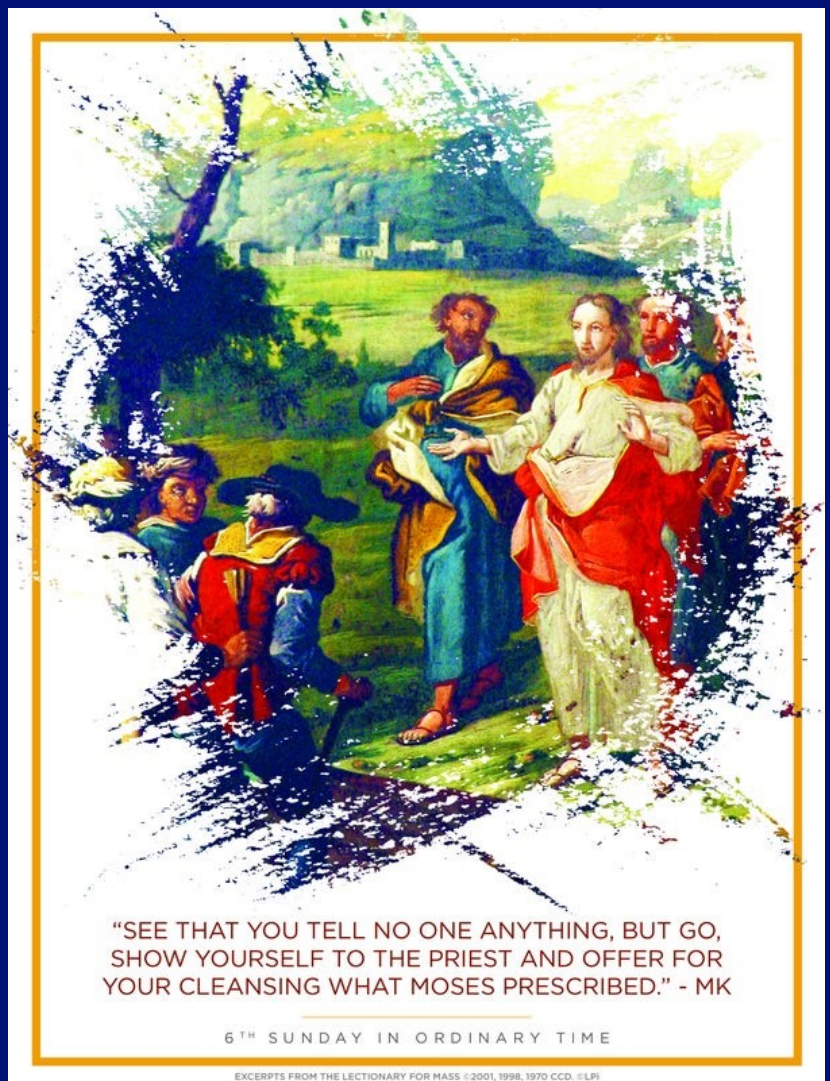

Barrera Reservoir Project

Dear Parish Family and Friends,

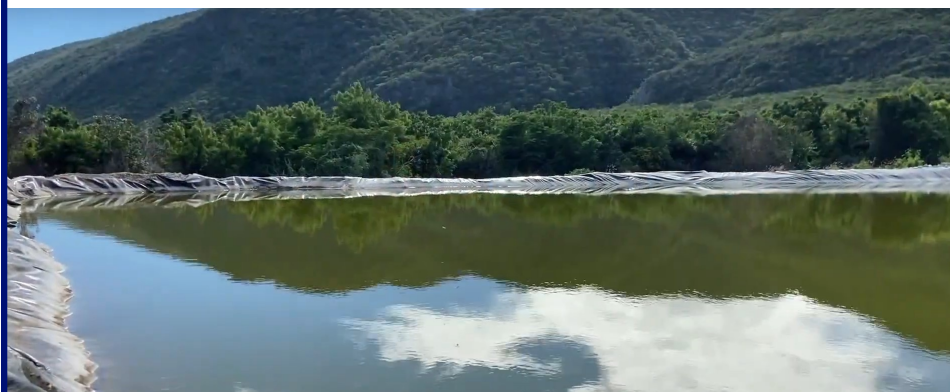
As Lent approaches and we likewise reflect on our own lives and do away with what is unnecessary and distracts us from God, it is likewise important to consider what others need to assist them in making their life less difficult to live. For the poor, difficulties can be found at every junction, whether in finding good work, growing food, or in raising a family, for example.

In the last year, the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist and Holy Apostles in New Berlin sponsored the building of a reservoir in the community of Barrera. Barrera is part of the greater La Sagrada Familia parish community and is especially poor. Prior to the reservoir, the forty-five farmers struggled to channel and collect water from the highlands for irrigating their crops. A reservoir was needed to collect and store the water. This will dramatically better the lives of many families who had resorted to making charcoal to make ends meet at the expense of the neighboring forests. This year, the Cathedral is seeking to build simple but sturdy houses for at need families. There are several families living in shacks with dirt floors and without sturdy walls. The cost per house is approximately \$7,000 and will go a long way to making the lives of a head of household and respective children much easier.

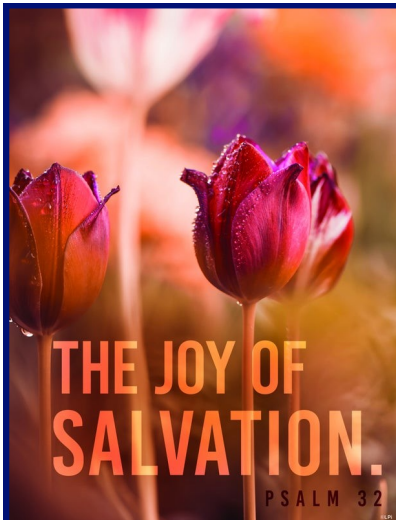

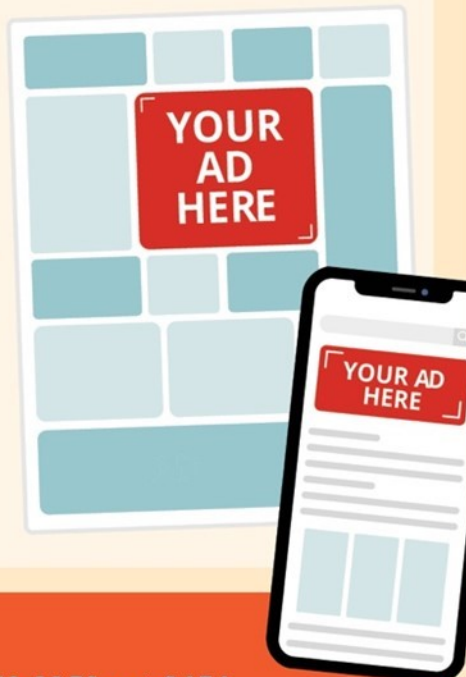
